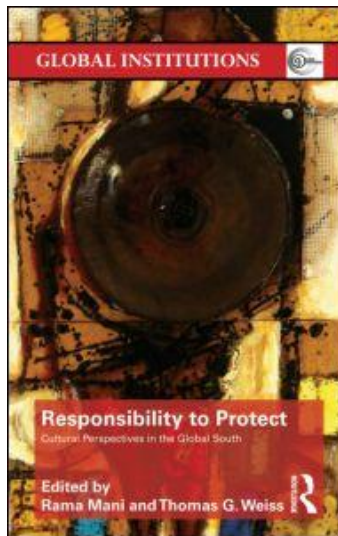


Responsibility to Protect: Cultural Perspectives in the Global South
